## **Tenure Line Transfer of Faculty Guidelines**

These recommendations pertain to requests for voluntary tenure line transfer initiated by the faculty member. Per communication with the Chancellors Office (2/17/2012), voluntary tenure line transfer falls outside the CBA.

- 1. Request must be initiated by faculty member.
- 2. Request will be considered based on the following:
  - a. Significant changes in the academic discipline and the faculty member's role within that discipline, AND
  - b. Overall benefit to the university
- 3. Provost may deny request at any point in the process.

Steps in the process:

- 4. Faculty submits request to Provost in writing via receiving College Dean and Associate Provost for Faculty Affairs
- 5. Provost contacts current College Dean
- 6. AP for Faculty Affairs meets with faculty member and consults with current College Dean to explore options other than a tenure line transfer. This step may take place before submission of written request
- 7. AP for Faculty Affairs forwards recommendation to Provost
- 8. Provost contacts the relevant College Deans
- 9. Dean of receiving college contacts chair of receiving department. Faculty of receiving department have an opportunity to accept the transfer
- 10. Provost makes final decision
- 11. Decision conveyed to faculty member via AP for Faculty Affairs

## **Considerations for departments and colleges**

- o RTP implications (if any) for faculty member requesting transfer
- RTP implications (if any) for **department and/or college** receiving transfer. Is current RTP criteria appropriate for new faculty?
- Consultations with both departments for awareness
- Impact on **T/TT faculty teaching assignments** for each department (so as all faculty are aware that these happening prior to the transfer)
- o Impact on lecturer hiring for each department
- Impact on future searches for each department as the student/faculty ratio shifts in each
  (this can drop receiving department on the priority list for TT searches)
  - Are DTD committees consulted as well?
- Are RTP committees consulted as well?
